The Dawson Scholarship

2010

The Dawson Scholarship was created in the year 2000 to encourage young professionals to join the profession of licensing and business development in the pharmaceutical industry.

The Scholarship is awarded annually and will be given to a person who :

- currently works either in industry or academia in a licensing and business development or technology transfer role within the healthcare arena

If working in the industry, the applicant's employer must meet the following criteria :

- be a company with less than fifty (50) employees
- have a turnover of less than 2 million euros (€2m) or
- be an academic institution

In addition, the applicant must :

- have less than three (3) years experience in a business development or technology transfer role
- have not previously attended a PLG Training Course
- not have applied for the Dawson Scholarship previously

The Award consists of free participation in either one of the PLG Introductory Courses being run in 2010, or a single module of the MSc Course.

Applicants should provide a 500-word statement on the benefits they would expect to derive from completing their chosen course. This should be sent to the PLG's Education Committee who will convene a panel to review the applications. The panel will consist of at least four members of the PLG UK Committee including either the Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Group.
